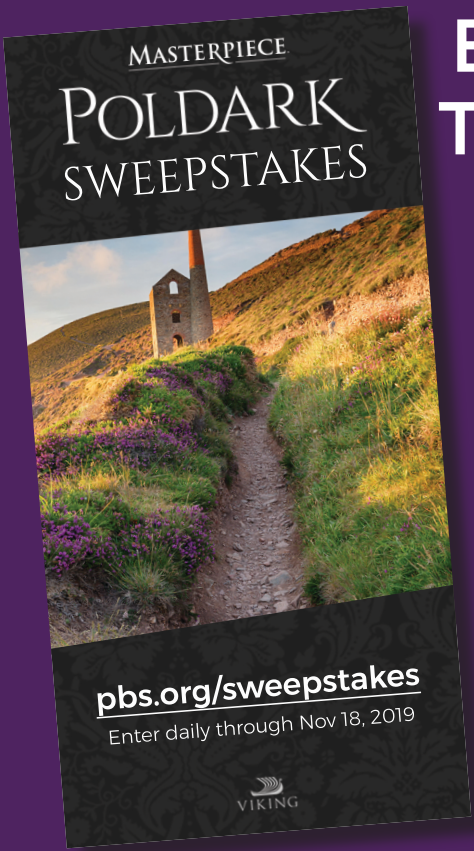

COLLECTING STORIES ONE TOWN AT A TIME

Everybody loves a good story, and if you're author, humorist, storyteller and host of OUR HOMETOWN on New Hampshire PBS, Rebecca "Becky" Rule, storytelling is in your DNA.

Becky has been telling and collecting stories in the Granite State for over 25 years. "They reflect our identity as a community and help define us," she says. "They also inspire." The author of twelve books, Becky is best known for her engaging storytelling presentations. She started out as a writer and developed an ability to connect with people when promoting her books, and it evolved from there.

She leads 40 to 50 storytelling sessions a year, many sponsored by the Humanities to Go initiative. Her job is to help people become aware of their stories and encourage them to pass on them on to their community. Her newest book, *That Reminds Me of a Funny Story, A Memoir and Compendium of Yankee Humor* was just released in September and reflects her life as a storyteller. "My stories are mostly true," she says, "and they're about real people."

Becky feels that the NHPBS series OUR HOMETOWN encourages people to share the stories that make their town special. She believes there's something special about the relationship people have with telling and listening to their own stories. "There's a call and response to the rhythm of it all. What I love most about it is that we don't hear from the usual suspects. There are always new voices telling stories the way they should be told."

In her travels around the state, Becky finds everyone so welcoming, and many wonder when their town will be featured on the show. Because the producers aren't telling the stories — the town's residents are — it's a major production and undertaking. She laughs, "There are more than 220 towns - we'll get to you. I have job security!"

She especially appreciates that OUR HOMETOWN is a resource for the whole community. All of the stories are preserved online. "It's an archive for businesses. Historical societies love it. Schools love it. People have pride in their community. I think it's really important and worthy of support."

Becky has long admired the mission of New Hampshire PBS. Her daughter Adi, who is also a writer, grew up watching children's programming. Becky grew up watching with her own family and still does. "I like that there are no commercials," she says. "There's always something good."

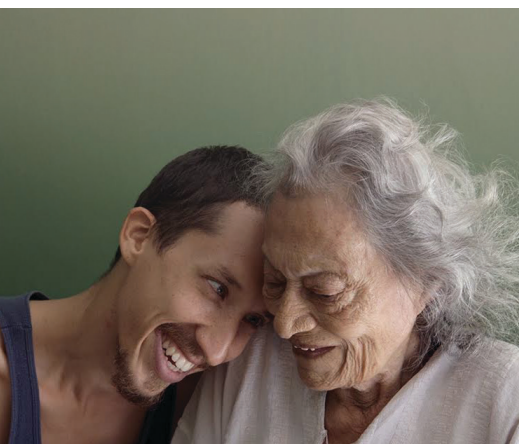

Tuesday, October 7th and 8th at 9pm on New Hampshire PBS. The mission of RETRO REPORT on PBS is to arm the public with a complete picture of today's most important stories. The series offers viewers a fresh perspective on current headlines, revealing their unknown — and often surprising — connections to the past.



In today's 24-hour news cycle, with breaking headlines, all-news networks and online

outlets constantly competing for attention, RETRO REPORT on PBS aims to widen the discussion, revealing the story behind the story providing new insights into how today's events have been shaped by the past. Each episode will explore four distinct stories, closing with "Now It All Makes Sense," a special segment featuring the wit and wisdom of author and comedian Andy Borowitz.



Topics to be explored include how decades-old research on human behavior shows that social media's addictive power is by design rather than chance; why half a million children still have dangerously high lead levels even though it was banned from gasoline and household products decades ago; how the sex education policies of today are

informed by failures of programs created during the Clinton era; and why mandatory arbitration agreements enacted on Wall Street 20 years ago have negatively impacted today's #MeToo movement.
